Working in collaboration and partnership with families, community members, and community organizations, the Family Services Coordinator will be responsible for creating a comprehensive program that meets the needs of and supports families and community members in improving their lives. The main goals of this new program are self-sufficiency, growth in personal finance & education and increased access to opportunities & community resources.

This is a full-time salaried position and is based at the affiliate office in Eagle-Vail. Applicants must be bilingual in Spanish and English, with advanced English speaking and intermediate English reading and writing skills. We are looking for candidates with excellent planning, problem solving, listening, communication and collaborative skills and are seeking an applicant with extensive experience, preferably lived experience, and cultural knowledge in a variety of Latino/ Hispanic/ Latina/ Latinx cultures.

Initial compensation is determined based on the successful applicant's qualifications and experience.
