The Construction Crew leader engages in hands on construction, leadership of team and volunteer groups, documentation of construction progress, execution of safety tasks and policies, organization and management of jobsite, tools and materials. The position demands a strong work ethic, an ability to work in all sorts of weather conditions, a willingness to lead and work with others, and an aptitude for hands on construction tasks.

Job Duties

- Maintain tidy jobsite including tools and materials organization
- Train, oversee and adhere to safety policies and procedures

Qualifications

- General knowledge of most phases of residential construction.
- Previous hands-on experience in residential framing.
- Basic ability to read and interpret construction documents such as architectural and engineering drawings, site plans, and technical specifications.
- Demonstrated coaching and/or leadership experience.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills and demonstrated ability to work within a team environment.

Compensation & Benefits

The salary range for this position is currently \$19.65 - \$29.46 per hour. This position is paid on an hourly basis and overtime is paid at 1 ½ the hourly rate.
