

## **Construction Crew Leader ~ AmeriCorp**

Habitat for Humanity of Vail Valley is accepting applications for an AmeriCorps National Construction Crew Leader. Responsibilities include preparing for volunteer groups and completing daily construction tasks; making sure supplies, tools and materials are available; preparing safety materials and work objectives for each work day; gathering information necessary to properly train and orient volunteers on construction safety and their assigned construction tasks; greeting volunteers and assigning tasks; training, supervising and serving alongside volunteers as they complete tasks; and documenting daily progress.

Applicants must have a high school diploma, valid driver's license, must be able to drive a non-commercial manual transmission vehicle and must have previous basic experience with computers, MS office applications, email and internet, previous experience in an area of construction and previous coaching or leadership experience. Desired qualifications include a college degree in an area related to construction, semi-skilled carpentry experience, ability to read construction plans, public speaking experience, volunteer service and conversational Spanish.

Term of service: This is a 10 ½ month position beginning in August during which members must complete a minimum of 1700 hours (5 days/40 hours per week) and serve through the end date on their Member Agreement. Outside employment or education is permitted during off hours.
