The Director of Construction oversees a team of 4 full time staff and 2-3 AmeriCorps members or construction interns. Responsibilities include construction program development, management of budget, procurement and schedule, overall project and site supervision, team instruction and supervision, management of safety programs, and oversight and development of community and volunteer engagement at the job site.

- 5+ years experience as a Superintendent, Project Manager or Construction Manager
- Previous residential framing experience
- Familiarity with green building strategies.
- Demonstrated coaching and/or leadership experience.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills and demonstrated ability to work within a team environment.
