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Scope of work:

Habitat for Humanity Vail Valley is issuing a Request for Proposal to complete the flooring work for the IK Bar Project on BLDG A, units 251, 253, 255, 257, 259 Bison Ln, and BLDG B, units 271, 273, 275, 277, 279 Bison Ln.

Organization Description:

Habitat for Humanity Vail Valley (HFHVV) is part of a global, nonprofit housing organization. Our goal is to build affordable, sustainable homes and to empower families through successful homeownership. HFHVV is the only organization in Eagle County that offers homeownership opportunities to hardworking families making between 35-100% AMI. Since 1995, HFHVV has built and renovated over 146 homes in Eagle and Lake Counties in the communities of Leadville, Vail, Edwards, Eagle and Gypsum. The IK Bar project is HFHVV's 3rd partnership with the Eagle County School District which allows local teachers and staff access to homeownership opportunities and helps with teacher retention in Eagle County.

Project Description:

IK Bar will consist of 2 five-plex, multi-family buildings with 2 two-bedroom and 3 three-bedroom units in each building. The two-bedroom units are 1660 sq ft and the three-bedroom units are 2040 sq ft, including a single car garage for each unit. See the attached plans for details.

Please provide a line itemed proposal broken out per duplex as follows:

- Carpet Material for 2 bedrooms, upstairs hallway, and stairs, approximately 525 square feet of floor area (not accounting for appropriate waste).
- Carpet Material for 3 bedrooms, upstairs hallway, and stairs, approximately 800 square feet of floor area (not accounting for appropriate waste).
- Labor to install carpet for the 2 bedroom, above listed area.
- Labor to install carpet for the 3 bedroom, above listed area.
- Laminate Vinyl Tile (LVT) Material or Stone Polymer Composite (SPC) for downstairs living room, kitchen, and hallway, both bathrooms, and upstairs laundry room, approximately 715 square feet of floor area (not accounting for appropriate waste)
- Labor to install LVT or SPC for the above listed area

Notes and Conditions

- Contractor will pull Town of Gypsum permits, which Habitat will pay for.
- Contractor will provide labor and appropriate tools.

Since Habitat is a not-for-profit home builder, we kindly ask that you consider donating a portion of the labor and/or materials. In an effort to keep our homes affordable to hardworking families in the community, any use of volunteer labor where possible to lower labor costs is encouraged can be discussed. If you choose to help us with our mission, please let us know so we can acknowledge your support fully!

Habitat's Director of Construction will issue a Notice to Proceed once all contract documents are completed. Work is required to begin within two weeks of Notice to Proceed.

Bidding Requirements:

Prior to beginning on-site work, Habitat for Humanity requires that the **sub-contractor provide a W9 and certificate of insurance with a workers' compensation policy** or, if an individual, complete an Independent Contractor Status Form.

For additional work above and beyond the scope of work specified, please provide an hourly rate charge for service.
